And I'm incredibly grateful to all our supporters, staff, volunteers, and community partners. Thank you for your unwavering dedication and generosity as you join us in our vital work.

I'm thrilled that together we not only kept our 24/7 emergency Family Housing and Pathways shelters going strong, but also expanded our support for families at The Meadowlark through our new Family Wrap-Around Care Pilot Project. We are working to build brighter futures for the families we serve by connecting them to skill-building, counseling and behavioral health support.

I'm excited to share some news about our Pathways domestic and sexual violence program. As of today, we are already <u>halfway to our fundraising goal of \$20,000</u> by the end of the year. Your generosity is making a real difference in the lives of those we serve.

Last year alone, Pathways supported over 1500 individuals, including over 200 adults and children who sought safety at our shelter in The Meadowlark after fleeing violent homes. Pathways goes beyond providing shelter, though; our program also offers counseling, legal support, and advocacy to help survivors heal and achieve their goals. And thanks to your support, starting this year, we are now able to welcome pets into our shelter as well.

You are the secret ingredient at the heart of all of this good work. So let's keep the momentum going. Your continued support will help us reach our goal and ensure that the Pathways program remains a beacon of hope for those in Missoula. Thank you for standing with us in creating a stronger, more supportive community for everyone.
